A. Western Ohio Pediatric Society

- PRINS – The PRINS manuscript will be revised and be submitted to The Southern Medical Journal spring 2007.
- ADHD- Manuscript in progress to be submitted to Pediatrics.
- Maternal Mental Health in the Ohio Pediatric Research Consortium (OPRC)-
  - Data from 417 surveys entered, 253 surveys completed and need to be entered
  - Awaiting base IRB approval at the Wright-Patterson AFB (WPAFB). Six providers at WPAFB Pediatric Clinic interested in participating.
  - Alyssa Gans will present an poster at AHRQ National PBRN meeting in May 2007.
  - Abstract submitted for European Society for Pediatric Research Meetings Fall 2007 in Prague
  - Abstract for Pediatric Academic Societies' national meeting was not accepted.
- Social Capital Study-
  - The number of surveys completed 150-200 in specialty clinic and primary care clinics. Data collection will continue in Dr. Kasten's specialty clinic and at the Rocking Horse Center later in May 2007 and The Children's Health Clinic summer 2007.
  - Greg will talk to John Thomas (PRI-Med Huber Heights) about participating.
- Fever study
