1. ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Jack Pascoe, Adrienne Stolfi and Mary Ormond were the recipients of the *Journal of Pediatric Health Care's* Ellen Rudy Clore Excellence in Research Writing Award for 2006. Their article "Correlates of Mothers' Persistent Depressive Symptoms: A National Study" was selected as the outstanding research article of the year.
- **Congratulations to Shalini Forbis and Adrienne Stolfi on the publication of the Firearms paper. It is the first PBRN paper accepted for publication.**
- Color copies of the PBRN National Resource Center certificate are available (the original is on display in the Cox Building).
- Mary Crimins announced that The Center for Healthy Communities' HIEx™ system database now includes information on 5000 of the 15,000 students in the Dayton Public School system.
- The Center for Healthy Communities is interested in applying for a grant examining the impact of shared electronic community health record on the quality of care for low income, uninsured individuals in collaboration with SOAR-Net.
