4. PROJECTS REPORT

- PRINS – The revised PRINS manuscript was submitted to The Southern Medical Journal the end of June 2007.
- ADHD- Manuscript in progress to be submitted to Pediatrics. Jack to talk to Sandy Mendel.
- Maternal Mental Health in the Ohio Pediatric Research Consortium (OPRC)
 - Sandy to complete data entry on maternal surveys received from Cornerstone (Ann Burke) and David Little's practice.
 - Alyssa to collect data in Yellow Springs at David Little's practice in July 2007.
 - Andrew to address Dr. Vananzi's (Medical Facility Commander Director of Medical Education and chair of the WPAFB IRB) concerns regarding validated depression screening questions. The study does not meet expedited review criteria.
 - The IRB would like those mother's that score a positive depression screen to be identified and for an intervention to occur.
 - Andrew will discuss with the WPAFB Pediatric clinic staff the feasibility of reviewing surveys during patient appointments
 - There should not be names on the surveys when we receive them.
 - Sandy to send Andrew copies of the WSU IRB responses
- Social Capital Study
 - The number of surveys completed 350 in specialty clinic and primary care clinics.
 - Data collection continues at the Rocking Horse Center July 2007
 - Jack will meet with The Children's Health Clinic staff on Wednesday July 11, 2007 to discuss starting data collection there this summer.
 - Sandy to submit continuing review report later this month.
- Fever study
