4. PROJECTS REPORT

- PRINS – The PRINS manuscript will be revised and be submitted to The Southern Medical Journal the end of June 2007.
- ADHD- Manuscript in progress to be submitted to Pediatrics. Jack to talk to Sandy Mendel.
- Maternal Mental Health in the Ohio Pediatric Research Consortium (OPRC)-
  - Jenn Rammel is completing data entry on maternal surveys received from Combined Health District, PRI-Med (Huber Heights) and South Dayton

Pediatrics. When finished with data collection, will have close to 1000 completed surveys.

- Wright-Patterson AFB (WPAFB) Medical Facility Commander William Venanzi, COL, M.D., chair of the WPAFB IRB mentioned concerns regarding validated depression screening questions.
  - The IRB would like those mother's that score a positive depression screen to be identified and for an intervention to occur.
  - For our study, we would like the surveys to remain anonymous.
  - Additional information was submitted to Randolph AFB in early June. Approval from Randolph is needed prior to beginning study at WPAFB Pediatric Clinic.
- Alyssa Gans will present a poster at the Center for Healthy Communities' Annual Meeting on Wednesday June 20, 2007.
- Social Capital Study-
  - The number of surveys completed 327 in specialty clinic and primary care clinics. Data collection will continue in Dr. Kasten's specialty clinic throughout the summer with Alyssa Gans participating in data collection June/July 2007.
  - Data collection began at the Rocking Horse Center in May 2007
  - Jack will meet with The Children's Health Clinic staff on Wed. July 11, 2007.
