1. ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- The 2007 AHRQ National PBRN Research Conference was held on May 16-18, 2007 in Bethesda, Maryland. Attending this year's conference was Jack Pascoe, Greg Eberhart and medical students Alyssa Gans and Kate Joyce. Comments regarding the meeting were
 - SOAR-Net had a larger attendance than any other PBRN in Ohio.
 - Discussions of strengthening smaller PBRNs through collaborations with Family Medicine PBRNs
 - Indianapolis not reapplying to be AHRQ National Resource Center, a new location will be chosen by Fall 2007
- June 12, 2007 6-7pm there will be a faculty development workshop on Cultural Competence conducted by Heather Biggers of Cultureflight, Ltd., followed by a brief SOAR-Net Leadership Group meeting.

A. SOAR-Net Sentinel

- The Spring 2007 (Volume 4, Issue 1) Soar-Net Sentinel is complete. It was distributed at the April 30, 2007 WOPS meeting and AHRQ National PBRN Meeting.

B. SOAR-Net website

- Greg will oversee updates to the website that will be implemented by Judi Engle. Greg to meet with Judi in May 2007. Changes to include:
 - New webaddress reflecting SOAR-Net name change
 - 4 new pages (including homepage and tabs) featuring updated contact information, tab for abstracts/publications and link to WSU med students webpages

4. PROJECTS REPORT

- PRINS – The PRINS manuscript will be revised and be submitted to *The Southern Medical Journal* spring 2007.
- ADHD- Manuscript in progress to be submitted to Pediatrics. Jack to talk to Sandy Mendel.
- Maternal Mental Health in the Ohio Pediatric Research Consortium (OPRC)-
 - Data from 417 surveys entered, 253 surveys completed and need to be entered
 - Awaiting base IRB approval at the Wright-Patterson AFB (WPAFB). Additional information to be submitted to Randolph AFB prior to beginning study at WPAFB Pediatric Clinic.
 - Alyssa Gans presented a poster at AHRQ National PBRN meeting May 16-18 2007.
- Social Capital Study-
 - The number of surveys completed ~200 in specialty clinic and primary care clinics. Data collection will continue in Dr. Kasten's specialty clinic and at the Rocking Horse Center later in May 2007 and The Children's Health Clinic summer 2007.
 - Greg will talk to John Thomas (PRI-Med Huber Heights) about participating.
- Fever study
 - Dr. Forbis and Kate Joyce (4th year medical student) are preparing posters for Pediatric Academic Societies and the AHRQ National PBRN meeting in May 2007.
- MRSA study
 - Greg completed final revisions to the questionnaire and will submit to Greg Kojola so that a web-based survey can be developed.
 - WSU IRB petition has been submitted.
- Future projects
 - Hypertension in children project discussed. The survey study of AAP Ohio Chapter physicians regarding attitudes and treatment of hypertension developed by Abiodun Omolaja, M.D., a nephrologist at The Children's Medical Center of Dayton. Dr. Omolaja met with the AAU project leaders last week to discuss the study. Dr. Chumlea agreed to help with the study.
