1. ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- The Maternal Mental Health and Social Capital abstracts were both accepted for the European Society for Pediatric Research (ESPR) meeting in Prague, Czech Republic in October 2007.
- The competitive renewal of the Health Resources and Services Administrations (HRSA) Academic Administrative Unit grant is due December 10, 2007.
- A faculty development workshop facilitated by Heather Biggers of CultureFlight, Ltd entitled Cultural Competence - A Model for Individuals Part 2 at The Children's Medical Center of Dayton was held prior to the SOAR-Net meeting.
- Marcie Knox-Hart, a junior in the WSU nursing program was hired as the new Research Assistant for the Division of General and Community Pediatrics in September 2007.

2. MINUTES – The July 10, 2007 meeting minutes were approved with minor changes.

3. FACULTY DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOPS—A workshop entitled Cultural Competence - A Model for Individuals Part 2 was held prior to the SOAR-Net meeting. Facilitated by Heather Biggers, the workshop was well attended. During the workshop, several different patient scenarios were discussed. - Greg attended the Community Advisory Board meeting on July 11, 2007 and reported the turnout was smaller compared to past meetings.

4. PROJECTS REPORT

- PRINS – Manuscript submitted to *Southern Medical Journal*, no response yet.
- ADHD- Manuscript in progress to be submitted to *Pediatrics*. Jack to talk to Sandy Mendel.
- Maternal Mental Health in the Ohio Pediatric Research Consortium (OPRC)
 - Greg, Cameron and Sandy attended the OPRC meeting on Friday August 17, 2007 in Columbus. No other members in the consortium are actively working on the MMH project. Reasons cited were lack of available staff and funding for research coordinators.
 - Sandy completed data entry on maternal surveys received from Cornerstone (Ann Burke) and David Little's practice.
 - Jack prepared two abstracts to be presented at the European Society for Pediatric Research (ESPR) meeting in October 2007. They were accepted.
 - Andrew reported that Base IRB approval was received for 250 participants in the MMH project at Wright Patterson AFB. The IRB required that informed consent forms be used to allow for screening and identification of depressed mothers.

- Social Capital Study
 - Data collection began in The Children's Health Clinic on September 4, 2007.
 - Alyssa to finish collecting data at The Rocking Horse Center in September 2007.
 - Sandy to begin conducting chart reviews at Ohio Pediatrics Inc., Kettering this month.
 - Sandy to begin collecting Body Mass Index measurements from Cornerstone charts in October 2007.
 - Marcie to begin data entry on collected Social Capital surveys.

- Fever study
 - Kate Joyce began her residency in early July 2007 at Rainbow Babies and Children's Hospital in Cleveland, OH. She will continue to work on manuscript and send to Shalini when a draft is prepared.

- MRSA study
 - Greg Eberhart to meet with Greg Kojola on September 21, 2007 to review web-based MRSA study.
