- PRINs – The PRINs manuscript to be published late summer/early fall in The Southern Medical Journal.
- ADHD - The ADHD Collaborative Study IRB Petition for SOAR-Net's participation with Jeff Epstein, PhD Associate Professor of Pediatrics in the Division of Behavioral Medicine and Clinical Psychology at Cincinnati Children's

Hospital Medical Center to be submitted next week. This will be a study of practice interventions to improve ADHD treatment.

- Maternal Mental Health in the Ohio Pediatric Research Consortium (OPRC)-

- Future projects
 - Blood Pressure in children and adolescents (0-17 years): Assessing dissemination of evaluation guidelines among primary care clinicians. A survey study of AAP Ohio Chapter physicians regarding attitudes and treatment of hypertension is ongoing by Abiodun Omolaja, M.D.
 - Bob Murray, MD and Michelle Battista (PhD Candidate) The Ohio State University to submit a proposal June 2008 for SOAR-Net participation in Acanthosis Nigricans project.
 - Student's working with Stephanie Riolo presented information on a potential project on Adolescent beliefs and attitudes about medication.
Comments included:
 - Focus on a more narrow age range *e.g.* 16-18 years old—potentially in Adolescent Headache Center
 - Focus on small number of racial groups
 - Ensure equal representation of gender groups
 - Focus on younger kids still in pediatric care
