4. PROJECTS REPORT

- ADHD Collaborative Study
 - Jeff Epstein from Cincinnati Children's would like to get 8-9 more practices in Dayton
 - The pilot project is still ongoing
- Maternal Mental Health in the Ohio Pediatric Research Consortium (OPRC)-
 - Data collection in progress at Wright-Patterson AFB (WPAFB) Pediatric clinic. (~135 collected so far)
 - Manuscript for publication will be submitted this year.
- Social Capital Study-
 - Civilian data collection of initial intake questionnaires is finished
 - Sarah Foley, student research assistant to begin working on data entry for chart reviews
 - We will write a paper and submit to a peer-reviewed journal within the year
- Future projects
 - Acanthosis Nigricans – IRB approval has been obtained. Michelle Battista (PhD candidate at OSU) will contact Dr. Stephanie Riolo to start collecting pilot data in her clinic.
 - Asthma – Dr. Forbis. Will recruit ~30 participants from Dayton Children's pulmonary clinic and from the Practice Based Research Network sites (~25 at each site)
 - Will focus on parent's understanding of child's treatment
 - Approximately 150 participants

 - Underinsured – original survey is from University of Colorado
 - Caroline is working on the IRB submission
