- 4. PROJECTS REPORT
 - Underinsured – original survey is from University of Colorado
 - We received approval from Wright State IRB
 - Over 1500 survey have been collected
 - We plan to submit an abstract to PAS in November
 - Acanthosis Nigricans

- ADHD Collaborative Study
 - The pilot project is ongoing
- Maternal Mental Health in the Ohio Pediatric Research Consortium (OPRC)-.
 - Data collection is complete (~1150 collected)
 - Abstract presented at the 2009 National PBRN meeting
 - We plan to write a paper to submit to a journal Summer/Fall 2009
- Social Capital Study-
 - Chart reviews are currently ongoing at the Children's Health Clinic
 - Abstract presented for the 2009 National PBRN meeting
 - We plan to write a paper to submit to a journal in Fall 2009
 - Jack and Adrienne are working on the analysis
 - We are waiting for WPAFB IRB approval
- Asthma – Shalini Forbis and Larry Goldenburg (med student) - Will recruit ~30 participants from Dayton Children's pulmonary clinic and from the Practice Based Research Network sites (~30 at each site)
 - Data collection is underway in the pulmonary clinic. 1 refusal so far
 - Will start at CHC on Monday, August 3, 2009.
 - Waiting for approval from WPAFB
