3. COMMUNITY COORDINATOR REPORT– Greg Eberhart, M.D.

- Greg Eberhart to complete spring SOAR-Net Sentinel Newsletter in time for the National PBRN Meeting in June 2009. It will be done in the next 3 weeks
  - Lead article will be about Ollie Davis Family Medicine Center
  - We will revive the “meet the practice” section. Cornerstone Pediatrics will be featured.
  - It was decided that paper and electronic copies will be distributed
  - Bill Spears volunteered to revisit the SOAR-Net mission statement and to make any needed changes
- Greg Eberhart and Caroline McNicholas completed the SOAR-Net membership email list – 46 members are listed

- The practice meeting at WPAFB will be delayed until July due to changing group of residents. Greg Eberhart and Caroline McNicholas will contact Tiffany Owens, the new chief resident, in early July to schedule a meeting.
- Bill Spears, Miryoung Lee, and Cameron Chumlea will attend future practice meetings with Greg and Caroline
- Bill Spears and Greg Eberhart were both unable to attend the CAB meeting today. The annual Center for Healthy Communities' annual meeting will be June 17<sup>th</sup> at the Dayton Cultural Center.

#### 4. PROJECTS REPORT

- Underinsured – original survey is from University of Colorado
  - We received Wright State IRB approval
  - 2 medical students, Mitali Pakvasa and Jessica Zagory, will be working on the study with us this summer. A STREM student will also be hired.
  - Jack Pascoe, Caroline McNicholas, Erin Brigham, and Greg Eberhart will meet to lay out a “plan of action” (e.g., which practices to include, which students will recruit which days, etc..)
- Acanthosis Nigricans
  - Pilot study data collection started in Stephanie Riolo’s clinic
  - Gino Roncallo expressed interest in doing this study at WPAFB
  - Michelle Battista and Casey Cook (undergraduate research assistant from Miami University) will come down to do chart reviews after apprx. 30 participants have been recruited.
- ADHD Collaborative Study
  - The pilot project is still ongoing
  - Greg Eberhart is expecting a call from Phil Lichtenstein
- Maternal Mental Health in the Ohio Pediatric Research Consortium (OPRC)-.
  - Data collection is complete (~1150 collected)
  - Abstract accepted for the 2009 National PBRN meeting
  - We plan to write a paper to submit to a journal within the next year
- Social Capital Study-
  - Civilian data collection of initial intake questionnaires is finished (~750 collected)
    - WPAFB data collection to begin in the next few weeks. We hope to get 250 surveys collected.
  - Chart reviews are currently ongoing at the Children’s Health Clinic, Community Health Center, and at Rocking Horse Center
  - Abstract accepted for the 2009 National PBRN meeting
  - WPAFB IRB approval just received
    - Caroline McNicholas and Gino Roncallo will meet to plan logistics of participant recruitment
- Future projects

- Asthma – Shalini Forbis and Larry Goldenburg (med student) - Will recruit ~30 participants from Dayton Children's pulmonary clinic and from the Practice Based Research Network sites (~30 at each site)
  - Focus on parent's understanding of child's treatment
  - Approximately 150 participants
  - Just submitted to WSU IRB under expedited review
  
- Bone Density Study – Miryoung Lee
  - high resolution MRI study of bone density
  - aim to recruit 200 kids
  - NIH funded
  - Would like to recruit through SOAR-Net
  - Participants get an MRI at Kettering, all other study procedures done at research park
