- ANNOUNCEMENTS:
 - 6 SOAR-Net abstracts were presented at the Annual Pediatric Academic Society meeting. May 1-4, 2010.
 - The Social Capital and Underinsured study abstracts were presented at the Child Health Services Research Meeting in Boston, MA, AHRQ Annual Practice Based Research Network Meeting in Bethesda, MD, and the European Academy of Pediatrics Meeting in Copenhagen, Denmark.
 - Jack presented the underinsurance study at the American Academy of Pediatrics Meeting in San Francisco, CA
 - The faculty development grant was not funded. However, we did received a high score.
 - We will collaborate with Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP) on a factor analysis comparing our results on the Maternal Social Support Index. Thanks to Adrienne for sharing the data with CHOP.
 - Greg and Caroline are working on an article for Pediatric Forum, due by the end of October.
 - Bill submitted a workshop abstract for PAS 2011.

- 3. COMMUNITY COORDINATOR REPORT– Greg Eberhart, M.D.
 - Greg, Caroline, Bill, and Miryoung have visited Pediatric Associates of Dayton, Northwest Dayton Pediatrics, South Dayton Pediatrics, Children's Health Clinic, and Ohio Pediatrics to present data on the underinsured study
 - All physicians have agreed to recruit parents for the Parental Advisory Board
 - The Spring 2010 newsletter is published and was distributed at the PBRN meeting

- 4. PROJECTS REPORT
 - Underinsured – original survey is from University of Colorado
 - Over 2000 surveys have been collected
 - Abstract presented at PAS for the 2010 annual meeting in Vancouver, B.C.
 - Abstract presented at the 2010 PBRN meeting in Bethesda, MD

- We are presently doing an additional round of data collection with the goal of collecting 1200 surveys
- Platform session at the 2010 AAP meeting in San Francisco, CA
- Jack will present a poster at the European Academy of Pediatrics meeting in Copenhagen, Denmark.
- Bill will work on abstract comparing 2009 and 2010 data for PAS 2011.

- Social Capital Study-
 - Bill, Jack, and Adrienne will begin work on the cross sectional paper
 - Abstract were presented at 2010 National PBRN and CHSR meetings
 - Jack will present a poster at the European Academy of Pediatrics meeting in Copenhagen, Denmark.
 - Diabetes data collection in ongoing at the CMC Diabetes Clinic
 - 206 surveys collected thus far
 - Miryoung is working on data analysis
 - We will submit an abstract to PAS on November 17, 2010.

- PRIME-Net
 - Key informant interviews are complete. They are currently being coded
 - Detroit and San Francisco completed their focus groups
 - All African American focus groups have been scheduled and will take place in November. Erin will lead the groups.

- Asthma– Shalini Forbis and Larry Goldenburg (med student)
 - Erin and Shalini will present an abstract at a Health Literacy meeting in Columbus next Friday.
 - Results indicate that parents are not good at using asthma action plans
 - The first draft of both manuscripts

- Fever
 - Under review at the Journal of Pediatrics

- Allergic Rhinitis
 - Jen is almost done with first draft of the survey

- Boonshoft
 - Audio tape data may be ready for PAS abstract deadline (November 17, 2010)

 - Approved by WSU IRB
 - Gino Roncallo would like SOAR-Net to use WPAFB as a site for this study

- Father-Daughter Relationship Study
 - Survey study assessing the relationship between father absence and adolescent females' drug use, sexual behavior, and body image.
 - Currently in review by the WPAFB IRB. Will be presented at the November IRB meeting

- Parents' perceptions of their children's overweight
 - Approved by WSU and CMC IRBs
 - We will send the protocol to investigators in Texas when approved by IRB
 - Protocol under review at WPAFB IRB
