- 3. COMMUNITY COORDINATOR REPORT– Greg Eberhart, M.D.
 - Greg, Caroline, Bill, and Miryoung visited Northwest Dayton Pediatrics to present data on the underinsured study
 - Physicians at Northwest Dayton Pediatrics agreed to recruit parents for the Parental Advisory Board
 - We will visit South Dayton Pediatrics next week
 - Greg received a call from Rebecca at Cincinnati Children's. They would like to resurrect the ADHD study.
 - Fall 2009 SOAR-Net newsletter has been published

- 4. PROJECTS REPORT
 - Underinsured– original survey is from University of Colorado
 - Over 2000 surveys have been collected
 - Abstract submitted to PAS for the 2010 annual meeting
 - Jessica and Mitali will both write recruitment sections for the article
 - Bill, Jack, Caroline, Mitali, and Jessica are writing the article

 - ADHD Collaborative Study
 - The pilot project is ongoing

 - Maternal Mental Health in the Ohio Pediatric Research Consortium (OPRC)-
 - Abstract presented at the 2009 National PBRN meeting
 - Paper has been submitted to the *Journal of Pediatric Healthcare*
 - We received positive feedback
 - Will resubmit as a new manuscript in March
 - More information will be added to discussion section

- Social Capital Study-
 - We have not heard back from investigators at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP) regarding the factor analysis
 - Bill, Jack, and Adrienne will start doing the analysis
 - Abstract will be submitted to the 2010 National PBRN meeting
 - Data collection is ongoing at WPAFB IRB
 - Diabetes and social capital data collection has begun at the CMC Diabetes Clinic

- Asthma – Shalini Forbis and Larry Goldenburg (med student) - Will recruit ~30 participants from Dayton Children's pulmonary clinic and from the Practice Based Research Network sites (~30 at each site)
 - Abstracts submitted to PAS
 - We plan to recruit an additional 30 parents of children without asthma to serve as a control group
 - Results indicate that parents are not good at using asthma action plans
 - Exploring the possibility of using video tapes

5. NEW STUDIES

- Barriers to mental health referrals
 - Caroline and Jack will work with Amy Heneghan, a San Francisco pediatrician and friend of Jack's, to construct a survey
- QD vs BID Amoxicillin for strep throat
 - Goal is to be ready to start by Fall 2010
- Parental attitudes toward Gardasil
 - Sherman Alter and Shalini will collaborate
- Parents' perceptions of their children's overweight
 - We will separate silhouettes by gender
 - Eric Slora at PROS willing to help find practices with high Hispanic populations
 - Mitali and Miryoung designed the survey
 - Target age is 2-19
 - Miryoung will send an email asking for feedback from SOAR-Net
