- <u>Underinsured</u> original survey is from University of Colorado
 - o Over 2000 surveys have been collected
 - Abstract presented at PAS for the 2010 annual meeting in Vancouver, B.C.
 - o Abstract presented at the 2010 PBRN meeting in Bethesda, MD
 - o Manuscript will be submitted to the journal Pediatrics this week
 - We are presently doing an additional round of data collection with the goal of collecting 1200 surveys

o Abstract accepted to the 2010 AAP meeting in San Francisco, CA

• Social Capital Study-

- o Bill, Jack, and Adrienne will begin work on the cross sectional paper
- o Abstract were presented at 2010 National PBRN and CHSR meetings
- o Diabetes data collection in ongoing at the CMC Diabetes Clinic
 - 206 surveys collected thus far
 - Caroline, Dr. Pascoe, and Dr. Breyer will meet to discuss frequency distributions and chart reviews

• PRIME-Net

- Key informant interviews are complete. They are currently being coded
- o Bill, Caroline, and Dr. Pascoe will work together to come up with a recruitment strategy for the focus groups
- <u>Asthma</u>– Shalini Forbis and Larry Goldenburg (med student)
 - o Abstracts presented at PAS
 - o Results indicate that parents are not good at using asthma action plans
 - Final data analysis taking place. Manuscript will be submitted by Fall 2010.
