- ANNOUNCEMENTS:
  - 6 SOAR-Net abstracts were presented at the Annual Pediatric Academic Society meeting. May 1-4, 2010.
  - The Social Capital and Underinsured study abstracts were accepted at the Child Health Services Research Meeting in Boston, MA and the AHRQ Annual Practice Based Research Network Meeting in Bethesda, MD.
  - We are in the process of submitting a faculty development grant. The focus of the grant will be education.
  - We will collaborate with Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP) on a factor analysis comparing our results on the Maternal Social Support Index. Thanks to Adrienne for sharing the data with CHOP.
  - We have a STREAMS student starting in June.
  - Cameron and Michele Chumlea will host the SOAR-Net Summer Dessert Party on July 2<sup>nd</sup>.
  - We will begin working on an article for Pediatric Forum, due October 4<sup>th</sup>.

- 3. COMMUNITY COORDINATOR REPORT– Greg Eberhart, M.D.
  - Greg, Caroline, Bill, and Miryoung have visited Pediatric Associates of Dayton, Northwest Dayton Pediatrics, South Dayton Pediatrics, Children's Health Clinic, and Ohio Pediatrics to present data on the underinsured study
    - All physicians have agreed to recruit parents for the Parental Advisory Board
    - Caroline will call the practice managers to get parent names
    - Dr. Roer from Pediatric Associates of Dayton is interested in doing a study on parent attitudes toward school lunches
  - We will schedule a time to go to Primed Wright Dunbar to present underinsured data to Alonzo Patterson's office
  - Greg and Bill will present the underinsured data the next Community Advisory Board meeting.
  - The Spring 2010 newsletter will be ready in time for the PBRN meeting in June
  
- 4. PROJECTS REPORT
  - Underinsured – original survey is from University of Colorado

- Over 2000 surveys have been collected
- Abstract accepted by PAS for the 2010 annual meeting
- Bill, Jack, and Caroline are currently writing the paper. It will be ready to submit by summer 2010.
- We will do an additional round of data collection in summer 2010.
- Maternal Mental Health
  - Abstract presented at the 2009 National PBRN meeting
  - Paper has been accepted for publication in the *Journal of Pediatric Healthcare*
- Social Capital Study-
  - Bill, Jack, and Adrienne will begin work on the cross sectional paper
  - Abstract were accepted at 2010 National PBRN and CHSR meetings
  - Data collection is ongoing at WPAFB
  - Diabetes data collection in ongoing at the CMC Diabetes Clinic
    - 175 surveys collected thus far
- PRIME-Net
  - Key informant interviews are complete. They are currently being coded
  - Bill, Caroline, and Jack will work together to come up with a recruitment strategy for the focus groups
- Asthma– Shalini Forbis and Larry Goldenburg (med student)
  - Abstracts presented at PAS
  - Results indicate that parents are not good at using asthma action plans
  - Currently doing the data analysis for the group of control parents

## 5. NEW STUDIES

- Barriers to mental health referrals
  - Caroline and Jack are working with Amy Heneghan, a San Francisco pediatrician and friend of Jack's, to construct a survey
    1. We are waiting on Dr. Heneghan's feedback on the questionnaire
  - Gino Roncallo would like SOAR-Net to use WPAFB as a site for this study
- Parental attitudes toward Gardasil
  - Sherman Alter and Shalini will collaborate
- Father-Daughter Relationship Study
  - Survey study assessing the relationship between father absence and adolescent females' drug use, sexual behavior, and body image.
- Parents' perceptions of their children's overweight
  - Protocol for the IRB is almost ready
  - We will send the protocol to investigators in Texas when approved by IRB
