- 3. COMMUNITY COORDINATOR REPORT– Greg Eberhart, M.D.
 - Greg, Caroline, and Bill met with physicians at Star Pediatrics in Xenia and they agreed to join SOAR-Net.
 - Greg wrote an article for Pediatric Forum on SOAR-Net. It will be published in February 2011.
 - Greg, Caroline, and Bill have attended 2 parent advisory groups. At the meetings, we discussed the possibility of using web forums to communicate with parents.
 - The Fall 2010 newsletter has been completed
 - Greg, Caroline, and Bill will once again visit practices to share data.
 - Healthy People 2020 will be the headline of the spring newsletter

- 4. PROJECTS REPORT
 - Underinsured – original survey is from University of Colorado
 - Over 3000 surveys have been collected
 - An abstract comparing 2009 and 2010 data was submitted to PAS 2011 meeting.
 - Bill, Jack, and Caroline are preparing the manuscript to submit to the Archives of Pediatric and Adolescent Medicine

 - Social Capital Study-
 - Bill, Jack, and Adrienne will begin work on the cross sectional paper
 - Diabetes data collection in ongoing at the CMC Diabetes Clinic
 - 294 surveys collected thus far

- Miryoung is working on data analysis
- Abstract submitted to for the 2011 PAS meeting.
- PRIME-Net
 - Key informant interviews are complete.
 - All focus groups are finished
 - Bill and colleagues are putting together the best practices
- Asthma– Shalini Forbis and Larry Goldenburg (med student)
 - The first draft of both manuscripts will be ready to submit by January 2011.
 - We will share our data with participating practices
- Fever
 - No changes.
- Allergic Rhinitis
 - First draft of the survey is complete. April 2011 start date is the goal.
- Boonshoft
 - Abstract submitted to the 2011 PAS meeting
 - First presentation to sites will be this Thursday.
 - We will write the manuscript in February 2011
- Barriers to mental health referrals
 - Pilot study completed at Cornerstone Pediatrics
 - Data collection ongoing at Rocking Horse
- Parents' perceptions of their children's overweight
 - Approximately 250 surveys collected so far
 - Low percentage without height and weight
 - Approved by WPAFB IRB

5. NEW STUDIES

- Father-Daughter Relationship Study
 - Survey study assessing the relationship between father absence and adolescent females' drug use, sexual behavior, and body image.
 - Approved by WPAFB IRB. Must now be approved by the Air Force Survey Committee.
- URI Study
 - Originally done by James Taylor, Professor of Pediatrics at the University of Washington
 - We would use the same questionnaire
 - October 2011 would be the ideal start date

- Allergic Rhinitis
 - Will be submitted to WSU IRB by February 21st
 - Goal is to begin data collection by April
