- 2. MINUTES – minutes from the January 5, 2011 meeting were approved
  
- 3. COMMUNITY COORDINATOR REPORT– Greg Eberhart, M.D.
  - The Dayton Parents Healthnet website is up and running. It is for parents in the parent advisory group, and can be accessed by invitation only.
  - The Spring 2011 newsletter will be completed by the National PBRN meeting June 22-24
    - Healthy People 2020 will be the headline of the spring newsletter
  - Greg, Caroline, and Bill will visit practices to share data in May/June 2011
  
- 4. PROJECTS REPORT
  - Underinsured – original survey is from University of Colorado
    - Over 3000 surveys have been collected
    - Bill, Jack, and Caroline are preparing the manuscript to submit to the Archives of Pediatric and Adolescent Medicine
    - Abstract was accepted to the 2011 PBRN meeting
  
  - Social Capital Study-
    - Bill, Jack, and Adrienne are working on the cross sectional paper
    - Diabetes data collection is finished
      - 300 surveys collected thus far
      - Abstract accepted for the 2011 PAS meeting.
  
  - PRIME-Net
    - Key informant interviews are complete.

- All focus groups are finished
- Bill and colleagues are putting together the best practices
- Asthma– Shalini Forbis and Larry Goldenburg (med student)
  - The first drafts of both manuscripts were submitted in January 2011.
  - We will share our data with participating practices
- Fever
  - Manuscript revision in progress
- Allergic Rhinitis
  - Study is being submitted to the IRB next week
- Boonshoft
  - In analysis phase
  - The health literacy component was implemented
- Barriers to mental health referrals
  - Data collection ongoing at Rocking Horse
  - Approximately 50 surveys have been collected
- Parents' perceptions of their children's overweight
  - Approximately 250 surveys collected so far
  - Low percentage of surveys without height and weight
  - Data collection ongoing at WPAFB

## 5. NEW STUDIES

- Father-Daughter Relationship Study
  - Survey study assessing the relationship between father absence and adolescent females' drug use, sexual behavior, and body image.
  - Approved by WPAFB IRB. Must now be approved by the Air Force Survey Committee.
- URI Study
  - Originally done by James Taylor, Professor of Pediatrics at the University of Washington
  - We would use the same questionnaire
  - October 2011 would be the ideal start date
