1. ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Friday, Nov. 4, 2011: Kevin Peterson from the University of Minnesota spoke concerning funding for PBRN research.
 - Networks with at least 20-30 practices are the most competitive for grant funding.
 - Dr. Pascoe suggests SOAR-Net begin looking for partnerships to build upon the current network.
 - Dr. Peterson can serve as a consultant on SOAR-Net grants in the future.
- Dr. Pascoe presented at the European Society for Pediatric Research in Newcastle, UK, held October 14-17, 2011.
- Dr. Forbis presented at Health Literacy Chicago, held October 17-18, 2011.
- SOAR-Net is submitting the following abstracts to PAS: social capital/diabetes, mental health barriers, allergy, and third year underinsurance

2. MINUTES – minutes from the September 7, 2011 meeting were approved with changes from Dr. Forbis.

3. COMMUNITY COORDINATOR REPORT

- Dr. Eberhart, Dr. Spears, Dr. Lee, and Ellen Jackson are visiting SOAR-Net practices to share data/ study updates and discuss practitioners' research ideas.
- At a recent visit to South Dayton Pediatrics, Dr. Sorauf suggested social media as an avenue for generating parent input.
 - Channel 2 broadcasts questions for viewers to answer on Facebook.
 - SOAR-Net could use this outlet to ask parents questions about timely/controversial pediatric health issues.
 - Answers would serve as qualitative inquiry into community voices and general parental interests.
 - Dr. Sorauf, Dr. Eberhart, Dr. Spears, and Ellen Jackson will meet to discuss intentions and a strategy for moving forward.
 - Dr. Eberhart will contact Vicki Giambone about use of the Dayton Children's brand.
 - Dr. Spears expressed interest in partnering with the Dayton Children's Facebook.
 - Dr. Chumlea raised a question of property rights to information on Facebook, which Dr. Eberhart will discuss with Vicki Giambone.
- The fall newsletter is in progress and should be distributed by Thanksgiving.

4. PROJECTS REPORT

- Underinsured
 - Third year of data collection still in progress

- 1000+ surveys collected
- The manuscript received positive reviews from The Journal of Pediatrics. Dr. Pascoe and Dr. Spears are working on revisions.
- PROS – Adolescent Health Study
 - PROS co-director Eric Slora has a positive perception of SOAR-Net. This study will be an opportunity to increase SOAR-Net’s national presence.
 - Study details from PROS are unclear (time needed, level of staff involvement, etc.). Dr. Eberhart will contact Dr. Slora about accessing study packet.
- Diabetes and Social Capital
 - Two recent abstracts to PAS 2012
- Asthma
 - Two manuscripts ready for submission following revisions from Adrienne Stolfi.
- Fever
 - Dr. Forbis plans to rewrite the manuscript with support from Dr. Pascoe
- Allergic Rhinitis
 - Data collection is complete
 - Analysis underway – Dr. Forbis will likely submit PAS abstract
- Social Media
 - IRB approval for parent survey received today
 - Ellen Jackson and Colleen McCormick will conduct pilot at Cornerstone and OPI Kettering later this month.
- PRIME-Net
 - Data analysis in progress on NIH study
 - Carol Lange at Minnesota involved
- Barriers to mental health referrals
 - Dr. Lee and Dr. Pascoe are submitting abstract to PAS
- Parents’ perceptions of their children’s overweight
 - Dr. Pascoe made contact with Karen Dorsey, clinical researcher at Yale studying Obesity in Latino pediatric populations
 - Dr. Dorsey expressed interest in collaboration
 - Dr. Lee sent her a Spanish version of the study questionnaire.
 - St. John’s is collecting through 2011 for approx. 200 surveys
 - Data collection will begin again following completion of underinsurance

5. NEW BUSINESS

- Workshops Underway
 - Dr. Forbis emailed a contact about cultural competence early 2012
 - Dr. Eberhart will contact Kate Cauley about early 2012
 - Med. Ed. workshop with Dr. Gjerde mid April
- Dr. Eberhart raised question of redoing PRINS (description of patient population)
 - Last was done 10 years ago
