4. PROJECTS REPORT

- Underinsured – original survey is from University of Colorado
 - Third year
 - Data collection is complete at OPI – Kettering
 - Near completion at Rocking Horse
 - Collecting at Cornerstone
 - Next location South Dayton Pediatrics
 - The manuscript is currently under review at the Journal of Pediatrics
- Social Capital Study- 300 surveys collected thus far

- Asthma– Shalini Forbis and Larry Goldenburg (med student)
 - We will share our data with participating practices
 - Waiting for Gary Mueller’s input and the health literacy component
 - Larry will submit his manuscript to the Journal of Asthma Management
 - Finished CMC & Rocking Hours sites
 - Needing 15 More from Cornerstone
 - Needing 50 more from OPI
 - Data entry must be re-entered.
 - Either in survey monkey or lime survey?
- Fever
 - Rewrite will take place in winter, possible submission to Journal of Pediatric Healthcare
- Allergic Rhinitis
 - Data collection will begin again next winter when there is more student availability
- Boonshoft
 - Dr. Forbis submitted 2 abstracts to Health Literacy meeting in Chicago
 - Writing in progress on both, the transcripts manuscript & the staff survey manuscript
- Barriers to mental health referrals
 - Approximately 475 surveys have been collected
 - Abstract for 2012 PAS
- Parents’ perceptions of their children’s overweight
 - Approximately 400 surveys collected so far
 - Low percentage of surveys without height and weight
 - Data collection will begin again this winter when there is more student availability

5. NEW STUDIES

- PROS – Adolescent Health Study
 - Long-term study (1-2yrs+)
 - Collect of 100 surveys per site (ideal)
 - Population positive/negative screening
 - Given either Social Media OR Smoking Cessation emphasis
 - Stipend available to participants
 - Need to invite practices to participate
 - Dr. Pascoe will find out ceiling age
 - Dr. Kellar will see if any residents in family medicine are interested in project
- Social Media – waiting on IRB approval (near complete)
