1. ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Welcome to Richard Rapp, new Research Coordinator
- Congratulations to Cameron Chumlea for receiving the Barge Golding Distinguished Professor of Research award from Wright State University
- Prime-Net received one of eight national awards from AHRQ for the establishment of a center of excellence under the Research Centers in Primary Care Practice-Based Research and Learning Initiative
- Bill Spears' paper on underinsured patients has been accepted for publication in *Journal of Pediatrics*

2. MINUTES – minutes from the May 30, 2012 meeting were approved.

3. COMMUNITY COORDINATOR REPORT

- Dr. Eberhart reports that PRINS is up and running. It was agreed that practices with multiple physicians would not collect 30 PRINS per physician, rather a total of 30 PRINS per practice per two week interval (3/day). Sites with multiple locations should collect information for two weeks at each site.
- Dr. Eberhart and Dr. Spears discussed their conversations at Prime-Net regarding possible social media interventions for conditions such as diabetes.

4. PROJECTS REPORT

- Underinsured
 - Has been accepted for publication, in print and journal by *Journal of Pediatrics* and 3 years of data will be presented at APHA in October in San Francisco.
- PROS – Adolescent Health Study
 - The AHS has been approved by Children's IRB. Dr. Eberhardt outlined the activities involved in the intervention and study. Both sites and SOAR-Net will receive stipends for being involved.
- Diabetes, Social Capital & Parental Literacy
 - Dr. Rapp relayed information from Dr. Forbis about this study. All chart reviews have been completed and Dr. Lee will continue to work on analysis.

- Asthma
 - Dr. Rapp relayed information from Dr. Forbis about this study. One manuscript is under full review. A second manuscript is under revision and will be submitted soon.
- Allergic Rhinitis
 - Dr. Rapp relayed information from Dr. Forbis about this study. The medical student interested in this topic will begin work on a manuscript.
- Social Media
 - 460 social media surveys have been collected from 8 practices.
 - A revised form of the social survey form is being pilot tested.
- PRIME-Net
 - See Community Coordinator Report
- Parents' perceptions of their children's overweight
 - 567 surveys have been collected from 10 practices. Beginning to look at data, Dr. Lee and Dr. Rapp will discuss next steps.

5. **NEW BUSINESS**

- Pediatric Partnership Project (PPP) is being developed. Two packets of forms, surveys were passed out. One contained Building Mental Wellness survey (Family APGAR, domestic violence and substance abuse screening questions and social support question). The second included items that are being assessed by clinicians for possible inclusion in the PPP. Some attendees rated the items at the meeting and some will send their ratings to Dr. Rapp. The same items will be distributed to local pediatricians on September 25 at the meeting of the Western Ohio Pediatric Society (WOPS).
