**1. ANNOUNCEMENTS:**

- Several poster presentations are up-coming by faculty, staff and students affiliated with SOAR-Net:
  - Pediatric Academic Societies Conference (May 3-6, 2014, Vancouver) Jack Pascoe, Meredith Pesce, Michael Perry and Richard Rapp will present posters on topics including parent-pediatrician partnership, social capital, and social media.

**3. PROJECTS REPORT**

- Miryoung noted that she still has not received a response from the University of New Mexico about her interest in recruiting Hispanic families for the obesity study.
- Health literacy study is proceeding well, about 50% of parents surveyed have been contacted for follow-up survey. No significant differences between parents who completed hospital survey and follow-up telephone call vs. parents who only participated in the hospital survey.
- Partnership study has collected approximately 536 surveys, 244 from sub-specialty clinics and the remaining 292 from community practices.

- Analysis of third year data from the under-insurance project currently on-hold.
- Shalini's manuscript to the *Journal of Asthma* was reviewed with major revisions required.
- BCHEP manuscript prepared for submission.
- Results from allergy study will be submitted to an allergy journal as soon as possible.
